That will put us in a position where we cannot be refused renewal, as long as we are here working for the Lord.

We are looking forward to a busy church schedule during 2019. We are excited about these opportunities of fellowship and service. Please pray that the Lord will use these activities to strengthen the believers here, and that we will see other souls saved through these efforts!
