Last month we mentioned the possibility of holding services at a retirement facility in SW Edmonton. We recently received a response from the facility. They are going to allow us to

meet on the first Sunday of each month in their chapel facilities, beginning March 1. This facility is quite large, housing an independent living unit and an assisted living unit, with several hundred residents. We are excited about the opportunity to carry the simplicity of the Gospel to these folks, and are praying that the Lord will allow us to reach out to many through this new avenue of outreach. This of course, is in addition to our regular Sunday services.

We want to thank each one of you, who spend your time in prayer for us and the ministry here in Edmonton.
