Dear Praying Friends,

We are truly living in interesting times! What seemed normal only one month ago is a far cry from what is going on today. As each day passes, it seems that the restrictions are more strict, yet the Lord is still good during these trying times!

As with many others, we were forced to move to online-only church services beginning the final two weeks of March. We would be much happier to meet with our people, to provide them with comfort from the Scripture, but that is just not possible at this time. We have taken this opportunity, where many false churches in the area have closed their door for the duration, to distribute flyers advertising our live-stream services. So far, we have been able to distribute over 800 flyers, as well as doing some advertising on social media. As a result, we have seen a number of “visitors” to our live-stream services. We are praying that the Gospel preached will draw souls to the Saviour, and that we will see new faces meeting with us after this is over.

Another avenue of ministry that the Lord has opened for us is offering free Bibles or New Testaments to Edmonton residents. We began this opportunity late Sunday evening, 5 April, and have already delivered four Bibles to homes across the city. Again, we are praying that the Lord will use this ministry to see folks saved.

One lost lady for whom we have been praying, Annabel Angell, has reached out to us during this time. She has visited our services off and on, but has not come on a consistent basis because her atheist husband is hostile to anything to do with the Lord. She has cancer, and seems to be slowly losing the battle. We were able to help her with some groceries that she needed, but wasn't able to get out to purchase. We are praying that this simple act of kindness will help to draw her closer to making a decision for the Saviour.

Someone recently asked if we planned to return to the US before the border closed. I had to chuckle at the question because the border had been closed for nearly two weeks at that time. In answer to that question, we would not return to the US even if the border was open. God has called us here and we have no desire to leave. I have heard of other missionaries who were required to leave their field of service. I pray for them and sympathize with them. I also thank the Lord that we have not been placed into that sort of situation. Instead, we will press forward, doing all we can do to make the Lord Jesus known.

Thank you for continually praying for us especially during this time!
