A Ukrainian couple has started visiting with us recently. They claim salvation and have been looking for a church recently. Please pray for the Lord's direction in their lives.

We have seen several people reach out to us in the past few weeks. These people have previously attended our services, or were some we were actively trying to reach with the Gospel in past years. Please pray that we will be able to meet with these folks and see the Lord do something positive in their lives, either through salvation or real spiritual growth.
