When we sit down to write our monthly prayer letter, we have the opportunity to evaluate what we have accomplished for the Lord Jesus during the previous month. Others are irreligious, and have difficulty recognizing their need for the Lord Jesus. We have been dealing with some of these folks for months, and others for years. It has taken time and effort to be where we are in drawing them to Christ, but we are not “there”

yet. Please pray for patience and wisdom as we deal with these lost souls. Please pray for the conviction of the Holy Ghost in their hearts, and that soon they will each make a decision for the Lord Jesus Christ.

We recently read about two new by-laws in Calgary. One bylaw prohibits anyone from distributing pro-life material. Another bylaw bans anyone from protesting the drag queen story hours that have become the rage across our world. If they can ban these things with a municipal bylaw, it will not be long before they ban anything to do with witnessing for Christ (door-to-door visiting, Gospel literature distribution, face-to-face witnessing, etc.). What has happened in Calgary usually comes to Edmonton pretty quickly. Please pray that we will be faithful until these things come to pass, and that we will remain faithful after these things have come to pass.

The desire of our hearts is to be faithful to the Lord Jesus. Please pray for us to be found faithful when he returns.
