Immigration News

We received a request for further information from IRCC (Immigration, Refugees, and Citizenship Canada) in the latter part of August. We have requested an extension to the deadline given, but we have not received a response from IRCC. Please pray that 1) IRCC will grant the extension requested and 2) that we will receive the information needed as soon as possible, and 3) that we will soon receive approval for our PR applications. Failure to submit the requested information could lead to a rejection of our application for Permanent Residence in Canada.

We are still seeing some response from our offers of a free New Testament. We believe that the Lord will use these offers to lead lost souls to salvation. Please pray that others will contact us for their free New Testament and that we will hear of lost souls coming to Christ as a result.
