In the beginning of October, we flew to Ontario to preach the funeral of Pastor Hugo Schonhaar. He was a friend, as well as a supporting pastor. Pastor Schonhaar had a love and concern for the Jewish people, and spent much time in witnessing to those he met. There were a good number of Jewish people in attendance at his funeral, because they knew that he cared for them. It was a wonderful opportunity to share the saving Gospel of Jesus Christ. Following the service, one Jewish lady, named Alise, trusted Christ! Afterward, she told me that she had found her Messiah! This is a wonderful admission for any Jewish individual to make. Please pray for Alise to grow spiritually. Her family have disowned her for choosing to claim Jesus as her Messiah. Yet, in spite of any hardship, knowing Jesus is the best thing that could happen to anyone!

We arrived back in Edmonton just in time to prepare for our Thanksgiving meal with those who are attending our services. We had a wonderful time together, focusing on how thankful to God we should all be.

We continued distributing John & Romans throughout the month of October. The Lord blessed us with good weather each time we went out. Each time we go out, we pray that the Lord will bless our efforts with fruit, and we believe that the Lord will bless us as we are faithful to Him.

We are thankful for the first time visitors that were present in our services during the month of October. To the best of my knowledge, these visitors are lost. Please pray that we will have an open door to share the Gospel with these folks, and that we might see them saved!

- Pray for Toronto Baptist Church, as they search for a pastor. Pastor Schonhaar's death has devastated them, but they want to go forward for the Lord. - With the passing of Pastor Schonhaar and their current financial situation, Toronto Baptist Church has not been able to continue our support. This makes three churches this year that have dropped our support (\$350/month). Two churches dropped our support because of the death of the pastor, and we do not know about the other church, but we assume that they are financially unable to continue support. We arrived in Canada with less than 90% of our support. Losing three supporting churches can be devastating. Please pray that the Lord will continue to enable us to make ends meet, by His grace.
- Please pray for the lost souls who have been attending our services. We are thankful for the ones who keep coming back, and seem so interested. There are some who seem to be under real conviction, but are not yet ready to trust the Lord for salvation. Please pray that the Lord will give us wisdom in dealing with each of these individuals, so that we do not become a stumbling block to their salvation.

Thank you so much for praying for us and the ministry God has given to us in Edmonton! We could not hope to accomplish anything without God's people standing behind us with faithful prayer!
